- Continued participation in Public Involvement Plan.

Actions Proposed to be Completed During Fourth Quarter of 2005 (October 2005 through December 2005)


- Respond to CTDEP comment letter pertaining to Final Investigation Report and Evaluation of Remedial Alternatives;
- Submit request to CTDEP for ground-water classification change; and
- If required by CTDEP, complete ground-water quality sampling round.
