Attached are the supporting documents we discussed at our May 16th meeting. The attached table includes a schedule summarizing our ongoing sampling, investigations and studies. This schedule provides the approximate timetable for the submittal of focused remedial action plans and various CTDEP deliverables. The attached plate shows all constituents (other than volatile organic compounds (VOCs)) which have been historically detected above applicable Remediation Standard Regulation (RSR) criteria on the southwestern downgradient portion of the Site. As shown, three constituents (ETPH, phenanthrene and selenium) were detected during single sampling events above the ground-water protection criteria and/or surface water protection criteria. None of the constituents were detected above the numerical RSR criteria for at least the last five sampling events. The concentrations detected are similar to concentrations of similar constituents detected in ground water throughout the non-public properties.

In response to your concerns that the fill deposited at the former Middle School site is different than that observed in the non-public property areas, we have attached a CD containing an interactive map which allows you to view photographs of test pits completed at the former Middle School site. To view the photographs, "double click" the paper clip links located next to each of the test pits. As shown, the various fill materials identified at the former Middle School site are visually similar to the fill LBG and the Town consultants observed in the non-public properties.
