Subject: Proposed Truck Transportation Route to the Tire Pond Closure Site  
Newhall Street Neighborhood Remediation Project  
Hamden, Connecticut

Dear Chief Wydra:

As part of the Newhall Street Neighborhood remediation project, we are providing you with the proposed truck transportation routes from the Newhall Street Neighborhood to the Tire Pond Closure site in Hamden, Connecticut for your review and approval. The proposed truck routes are presented below and on the attached figure. Specifically, the proposed main truck route is as follows:

1. Exit the Newhall Street Neighborhood by going west on Goodrich Street to Dixwell Avenue.
2. Right turn onto Dixwell Avenue and proceed north to the intersection with Putnam Avenue.
3. Right turn onto Putnam Avenue and follow east to Whitney Avenue.
4. Right turn onto Whitney Avenue and proceed south to the intersection with Davis Street.
5. Left turn onto Davis Street and proceed east to the intersection with Ridge Street.
6. Right turn onto Ridge Road and proceed southeast to the intersection with State Street.
7. Left turn onto State Street and proceed north to the Tire Pond Closure Site.

(Reverse the route to return to the Newhall Street Neighborhood, the only difference being a turn left onto Morse Street from Dixwell Avenue, as Morse Street is a one-way street with traffic flow from west to east, and Goodrich Street is a one-way street with traffic flow from east to west).

The proposed route above achieves the goal of routing traffic through main roads and avoiding residential neighborhoods to the extent practical, although it may not be the most appropriate route during all phases of the proposed remediation work. Depending on which Block is being remediated, it may make more sense to exit the neighborhood by travelling north on Newhall Street and taking a right onto Putnam Avenue (or when returning, taking a left onto Newhall Street from Putnam Avenue rather than travelling west to Dixwell Avenue). This alternate route is indicated with a red dashed line on the attached figure.

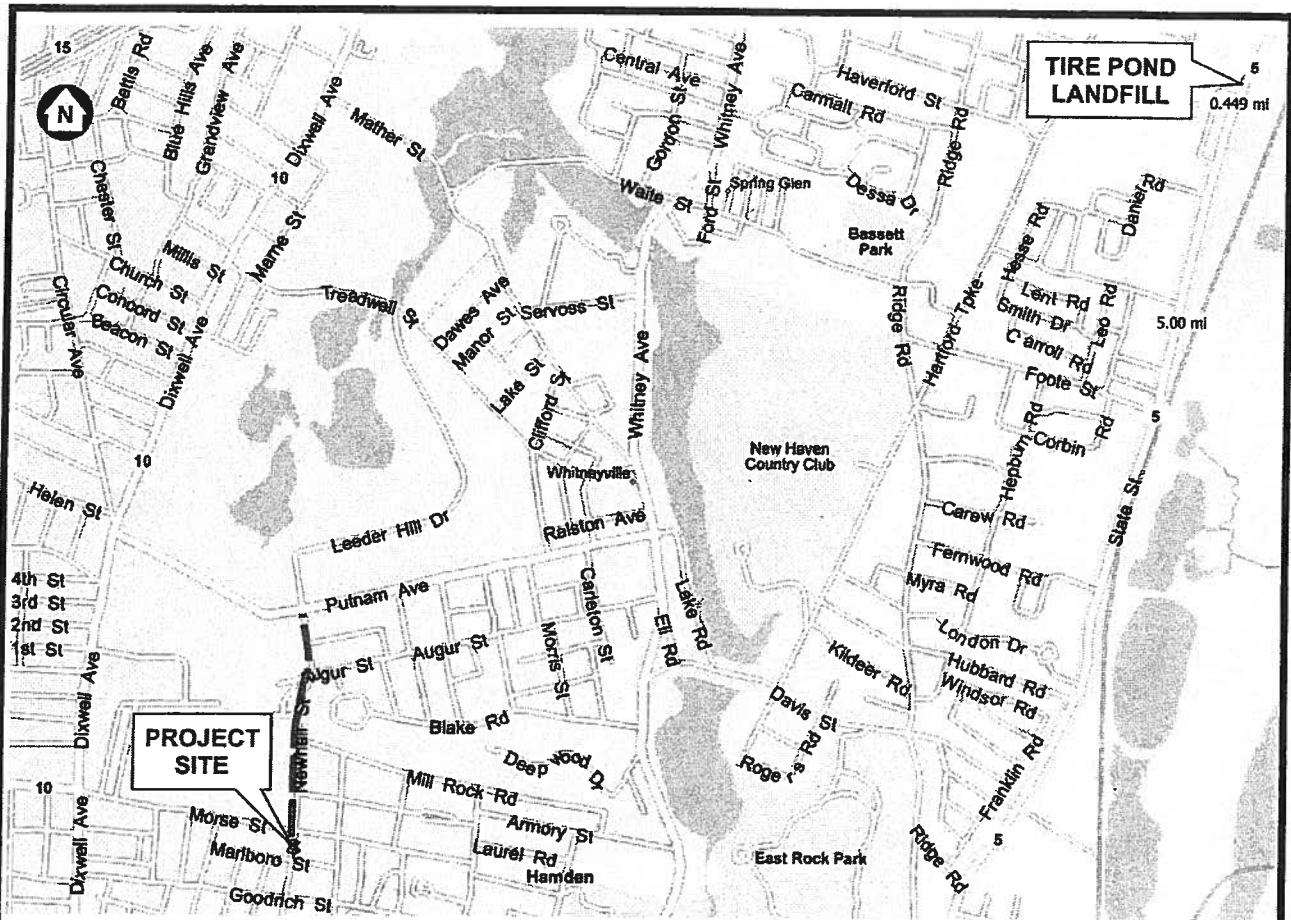

2. Turn right at Goodrich St • About 1 min • go 0.4 mi • total 0.5 mi
3. Turn right at Dixwell Ave • About 2 mins • go 0.7 mi • total 1.2 mi
4. Turn right at Putnam Ave • About 3 mins • go 1.2 mi • total 2.4 mi
5. Turn right at Whitney Ave • About 1 min • go 0.3 mi • total 2.8 mi
6. Turn left at Davis St • About 2 mins • go 0.6 mi • total 3.3 mi
7. Turn right at Ridge Rd • About 1 min • go 0.3 mi • total 3.7 mi
8. Turn left at State St/US-5 N • Destination will be on the right • About 3 mins • go 1.8 mi • total 5.4 mi
