At the request of Olin Corporation (Olin), through correspondence with staff of the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection's Remediation Division, the Department's Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division (WEED) is directing this letter to you regarding Olin's concern as to whether or not it must obtain an authorization for the disruption of a solid waste disposal area pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) Section 22a-209-7(u), prior to initiating the conditionally approved remedial activities for the Newhall Street Neighborhood Site located in Hamden.

Given that the Remediation Division has conditionally approved Olin's Generic Remedial Action Plan for the site, dated August 19, 2008, WEED will not require Olin to submit an application for the disruption of the solid waste disposal areas on the site. The Generic Remedial Action Plan adequately addresses the issues typically associated with disruption activities and said plan serves as a viable alternative to the authorization for disruption.
